## **HELPFUL HINTS**

Please ensure that your horse is groomed and ready and your tack is clean and accessible prior to your scheduled shoot. New halters should be properly fitted and broken in prior to the shoot to ensure a more “natural” look.

If you are looking to have conformation shots done, practice standing your horse up in advance to prepare. The horse must stand quietly on a loose lead/rein to achieve the best possible results.

If you are able to recruit an “assistant” for the shoot, it is highly recommended. The assistant can be a valuable tool when trying to get a relaxed, happy photo of your horse with their ears forward.

Try to “scout” the possible photo shoot locations prior to the arrival of your photographer. Although the photographer will be able to give knowledgeable advice as to the best possible locations upon their arrival, having suggestions in advance will help the shoot progress in a timely manner. Please pay particular attention to the time of day of your shoot and the lighting at your location. For the best results the sun should be at the photographer’s back. And most important..... relax and enjoy yourself!
